CEQB members have an ongoing obligation to conduct themselves in an ethical, professional, and lawful manner, and to identify and disclose actual, reasonably perceived, and potential conflicts of interest. These obligations are set out in case law and are also codified in statute, under the *Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act* ("CNCA"). Members that cannot act in the best interests of Engineers Canada or are conflicted should recuse themselves from the relevant part of the meeting, and they shall not vote on the decision at hand. Members must support the legitimacy and authority of CEQB decisions, regardless of their personal position on the issue, and shall not publicly discuss the varying opinions of individual members.

Frank Collins, CEQB Chair, presented: CEQB work plan consultation process completed:



- Feedback provided by admissions, practice, and discipline & enforcement officials groups

The CEQB, its Executive Committee, and the CEAB have discussed the University of Saskatchewan's proposal, and will provide their feedback through APEGS which includes potential issues discussed today.
