Iron Ring Ceremony

- The CEOs discussed recent concerns with the iron ring ceremony and, while recognizing the ceremony was not a responsibility of the regulators nor Engineers Canada, felt there was a need to advise the Corporation of the Seven Wardens of those concerns.
- The CEO of Engineers Canada will craft a letter on behalf of the CEOs articulating our collective concerns.

Per Capita Assessment fee

- While the CEO Group did not express a collective position on the per capita assessment fee proposal, it was felt that a longer lead time would be needed for the recommendation of the proposed fee.
- Greater consultation on this recommendation would have been preferable.
