Update on 2016-17 Work Plan

- Over the last 3 months, QB committees:
 - Held 18 meetings (as of May 25)
 - Completed 1 guideline, 1 white paper and 5 syllabi
 - Revised 1 existing guideline
 - Held 1 cross-country call (CPD officials)
 - Completed the work and stood down the Good Character Task Force

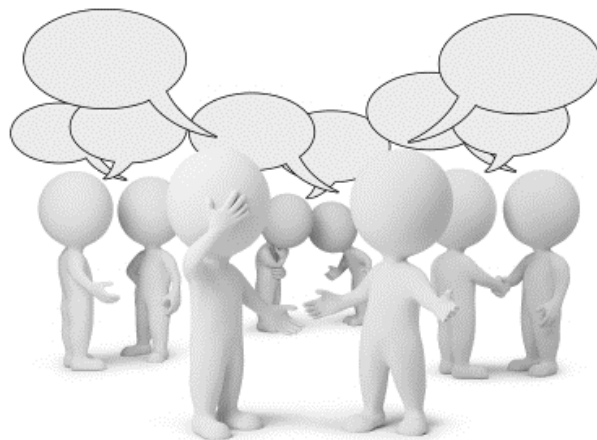
