Reducing Barriers to Interprovincial Mobility:

- Discussion on strategies to reduce barriers to mobility for engineers, including recognition of foreign qualifications and streamlining the application process



Harmonizing Continuing Professional Development

- Efforts to harmonize CPD requirements across the country to ensure consistency and facilitate easier compliance for engineers working in multiple jurisdictions.

Governance Review Discussion
