# Background

- CEOs and Executive Directors met virtually for one and half days on 20 and 21 May 2026
- 12 Regulators were represented



# Continuing Professional Development

## Objective

Regulators are working towards a national, harmonized concept for Continuing Professional Development (CPD).

## Current Status

- Professional Engineers Ontario (PEO) is leading the project, with updates to and guidance from the CEO Group.

## Next Steps

- The CEO Group has agreed to a work towards a macro level “Agreement in Principle” for our July meeting
- The next phase is to develop a full principles document and an updated CPD MOU
- Our long-term vision remains a national CPD program

# CEQB and CEO Group Interface

## Objective

Clarify the role of QB in supporting and receiving feedback from the CEO Group

## Current Status

QB support to the CEO Group is unclear

## Next Steps

- Define a clear and consistent role for QB in supporting the CEO Group
- Is current model still working?
- Multiple inputs from various groups - how are inputs prioritized?



# National Officials Groups

## Objective

To better define the governance and work efforts of the officials groups

## Current Status

Review the mandates of Officials Groups to ensure they are centered on regulator priorities

## Key Considerations

- Review of TOR, setting of priorities, linkage with AB and QB
- This will influence the broader governance discussion.



# National Discipline Cost Sharing

## Objective

Discuss the risks to smaller jurisdictions to offset large litigation costs

## Current Status

- Discussion on a on how smaller regulators are equipped to face large legal cases
- Early ideas introduced, with no agreed approach yet

## Next Steps

- Consider potential mechanisms or models to support cost sharing or risk mitigation
- Engage regulators to assess feasibility and appetite for options
